Is the San Poil Treatment Center Right For Me?

The Potential Client Must:

- ♦ Be 18 years of age or older
- ♦ Be vaccinated (or be willing to be vaccinated)
- Have a Chemical Dependency Assessment (within 90 days of admission)
- Have a medical clearance exam with orders (within 14 days of admission)
- ♦ Have Insurance or another form of payment
- Have adequate control over their behavior and assessed; not to be imminently dangerous to self or others
- Express a desire to recover from addiction to drugs and/or alcohol
- Be assessed as medically appropriate and free of any illness that requires isolation from others
- Have the capacity for active participation in all phases of the program
- Be ambulatory and/or meet personal needs without assistance

How We Can Help

The San Poil Treatment Center serves adults who have been diagnosed with a Substance Use Disorder (SUD) and classified as having a medical need for residential SUD services, as determined by the recommended ASAM Level of Care.

- Inpatient Rehab—Clients are in beautiful housing that provides a nurturing environment that promotes personal well-being and recovery.
- Traditional Healing—Healing through culture, spirit, traditions and heritage. Activities include healing circles, drumming, sweats, canoe building, cultural arts & more.
- Multidisciplinary Approach—Chemical dependency is complex and requires an approach to treating co-occurring medical & mental health disorders.
- Help With Insurance San Poil Treatment Center has two (2) certified Patient Navigators to assist with insurance.

How Long Does Inpatient Treatment Last?

The length of stay at our facility will depend on the individual. It is not uncommon for someone to stay at an inpatient facility for longer than 90 days, or even stay for less than 45 days. The length of stay will depend on the individual's substance use history and if they have attended treatment before .

Services provided by the facility will generally include:

- Individual and group chemical dependency counseling provided in an evidence-based manner wholly integrated with accepted traditional wellness practices
- Chemical dependency support groups
- Holistic medicine and cultural activities (including sweat lodge, language integration, and spiritual events)
- Community and family education and support services
- Additional ancillary services will be provided by the Colville Tribe Behavioral Health program to include a psychiatric medical provider, licensed mental health clinicians, and other services as needed
